# 3. Band Teacher's Report

### 3.1 Divisional Honor Band.

Focus mostly on Grade 10-12 students, to give more advanced challenge. Practice would be every second week. If there is lack of response, idea will not be pursued.

### **3.2** Grade Six band is new this year.

#### 3.3 Jazz Band

The goal is to increase membership. There is a jazz workshop in Winnipeg on October 26. Morning is the workshop and afternoon is a performance. Parents are needed to drive. The group fee is \$325.00.

Discussion of scheduling for choir and jazz band. For each to remain ½ credit, teacher needs to direct both classes per week. Do students in jazz band necessarily want a program with ½ credit? Ms. Kirkland will discuss with students.
