This fund was established in 2022 based on instructions left by Mr. Jack Waddell in his will. It is administered by the Park West School Division Foundation of Manitoba Inc. This fund is awarded to Park West School Division graduate(s) pursuing post-secondary education (college or university in Canda) for the study of agriculture or studies directly related to agriculture. The original donation has been invested. Each year, scholarships will be awarded from the income generated by the original donation.

Mr. Jack Waddell was born in Newdale, Manitoba on October 22, 1928, on his parents' farm. Jack was the 6th child of a family of 12 born to Allan and Lillian Waddell. Jack farmed at Newdale briefly and then worked for a farmer until he retired. He took a keen interest in agricultural practices and enjoyed talking about current farming issues with his nephews. Jack felt education was very important and made this donation to help students stay involved in any form of agriculture.

Jack married Anne Lawson (nee: Moore) of Miami, Manitoba, on June 28, 1986. After their marriage they moved to Miami, Manitoba. They were married over 34 years enjoying 15 winters in Southern Texas and many other various holidays with family and friends. They later resided in Carman, Manitoba where they enjoyed their golden years together.

Mr. Waddell was a quiet, soft-spoken, gentle man with a dry sense of humour. He enjoyed gardening, woodworking, old time dancing and shuffling, reading magazines such as National Geographic, travelling and exploring on trips to California, the East coast, Disney World, and on bus tours.

Mr. Waddell passed away July 12, 2020 after a brief illness. He was buried at Newdale, Manitoba.

- 2. be a current grade 12 graduate from Park West School Division,
- 3. be enrolled in a Canadian university, community college, as a Full Time Student,
- 4. be enrolled in a study of agriculture or studies directly related to agriculture,
- 5. remain a full-time student in an eligible agricultural program (as recognized by the educational institution attended) for all terms of the academic year;
- 6. provide an official transcript, confirming full time completion of first term by: JANUARY 15, 2024

- The selection committee will also consider applicants' grades, school, community and extra-curricular involvement.
- Funds are distributed after confirmation has been received from the educational institution that the applicant
 has successfully completed the first semester of their studies.
